

Complaints to the BBC: May 2016

The BBC answered nearly **19,000** complaints from the audience during May 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included concerns about the latest series of Top Gear from viewers who were unhappy with the new style of the show.

There were also complaints about the closure of the BBC Food website and the potential loss of recipes.

Finally, there were complaints about the amount of coverage BBC News devoted to Leicester City's win in the Premiership.
