

Complaints to the BBC: September 2016

The BBC answered just over **13,000** complaints from the audience during September 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from viewers of Question Time on September 15 who were unhappy with Anna Soubry MP's comments about John McDonnell MP and felt the programme's presenter should have intervened more.
