Interview:

Hakim: "So in Lyons... the best way to get around, is by bike. It's very simple, all you need is a card that costs one euro per week or fifteen euros for the whole year. You scan it in the machine, choose a bike and you can borrow it for a half an hour, an hour, as long as you want."

Nathalie: "Do you use a bike often to get around?"
